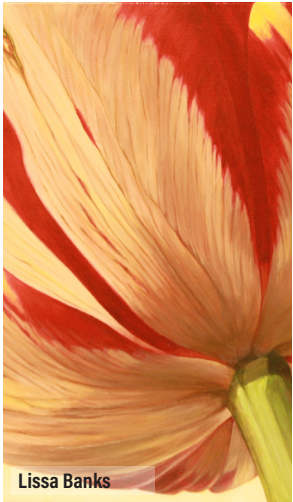
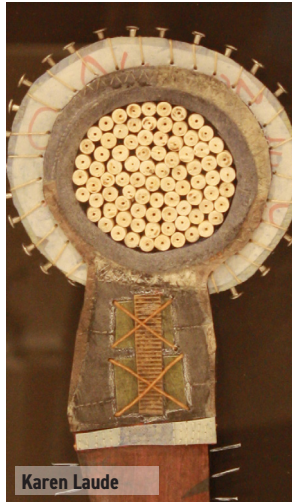


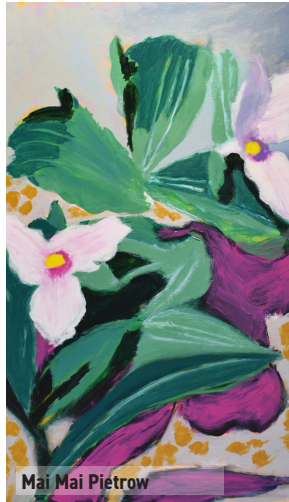

Up to three artworks that have not been shown at HCA may be submitted. Entry forms can be found at www.hopartscenter.org/gallery/call-for-art.

All 2D media may be entered, including photos, fiber art, and digital art. It must be wired for hanging. Maximum height and width for wall hung work is 42 inches.

3D work may be entered if it is free standing (does not require a pedestal) or can be hung on the wall and does not protrude more than 10 inches.

No sawtooth hangers or sandwich frames, please. No giclee prints, copies, derivative, or electronic reproductions will be accepted.
